Look for the Green Lane Markers

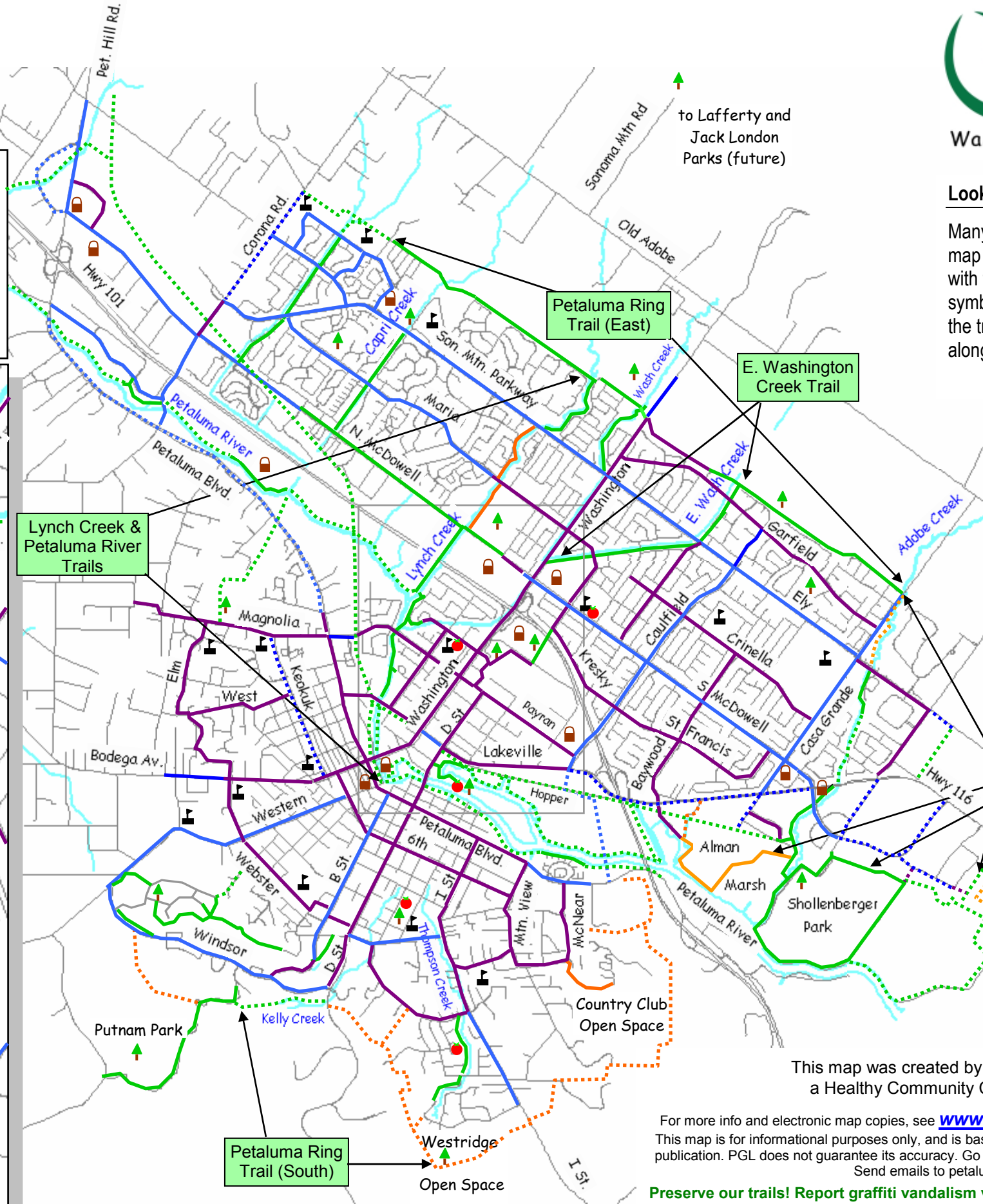
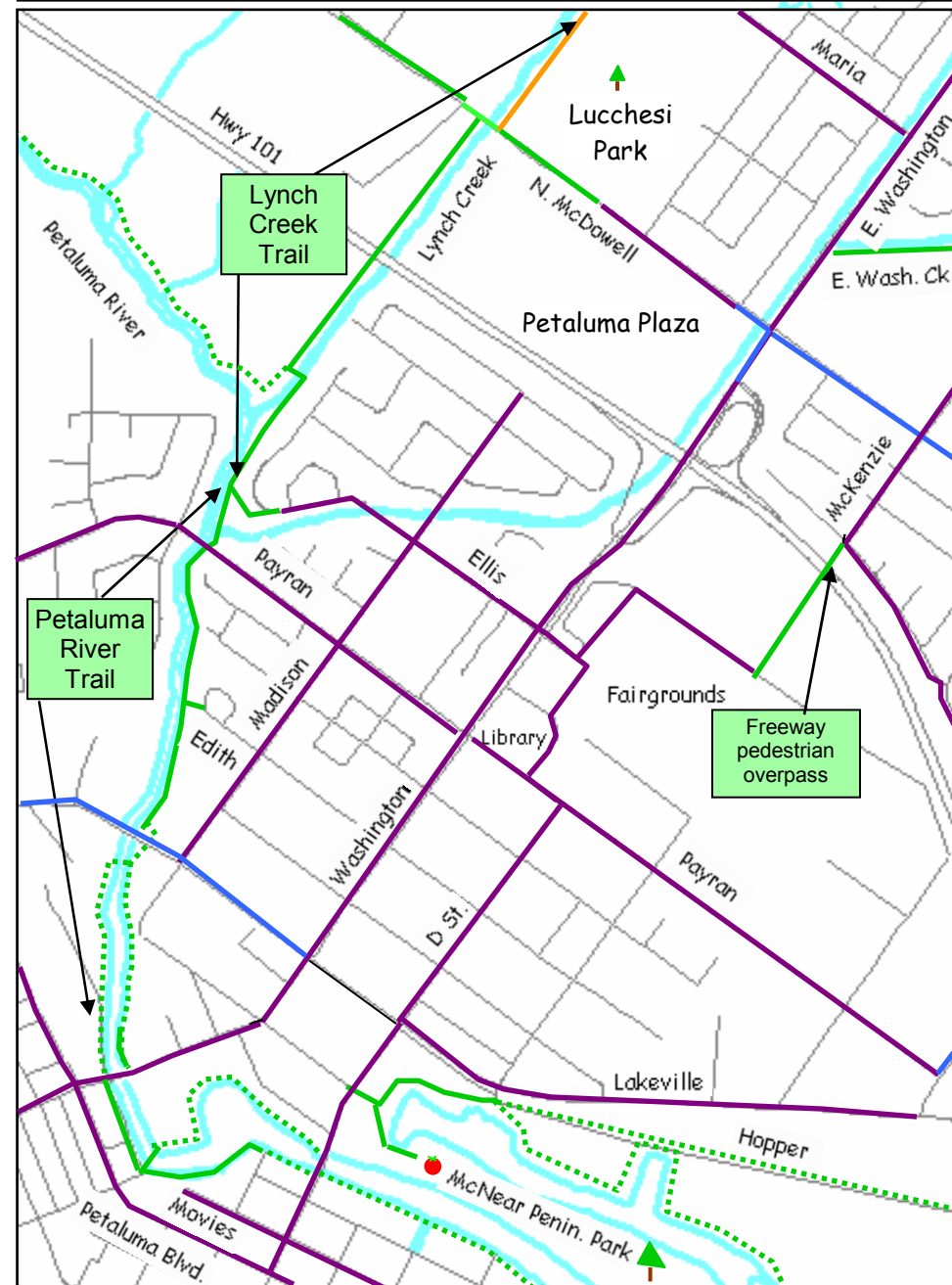
Many of the routes you see on this map will eventually be marked out with the Petaluma Green Lane symbol. It will point the direction(s) of the trail. Look for it on posts alongside trails.



Downtown Petaluma Detail

Use Lynch Creek Trail and the Petaluma River Trail to get from Prince and Lucchesi Parks to downtown. In the future, trails will extend along the length of the Petaluma River through town.

Presently, bicycle travel along Washington is not recommended. Use D Street or Madison instead as alternatives. Similarly, use D Street and Payran (or the future Hopper Street trail) as a bicycle travel alternative to Lakeville, which has substandard bike lanes.
